



DR. MICHAEL BRANDL is a Senior Lecturer at the McCombs School of Business at The University of Texas at Austin where he teaches managerial economics. He also regularly gives lectures in the Executive Education program at McCombs and is a frequent guest lecturer at the LBJ School of Public Policy at UT. Dr. Brandl's research primarily focuses on the role of financial markets in economic growth and development.
