Dr. Doggett is a Senior Lecturer of International Entrepreneurship and Management in the McCombs School of Business at The University of Texas at Austin. He is also a Senior Research Fellow at UT's IC2 Institute and Co-Founder of UT's International Idea to Product Competition™. Since 2000, he has spent part of each summer teaching entrepreneurship and venture capital workshops in Singapore, Austria, China, Malaysia, Thailand, Mexico, Korea, and Japan. He has received numerous teaching awards from McCombs MBA students in Austin and Dallas and was selected by Business 2.0 as one of the top two professors at McCombs. In 2002 students gave him the Outstanding Faculty Award for UT's Executive Engineering Management Master's Program. In 2003 he received a teaching award from the U.S. Army War College and the Texas Evening MBA Program. Doggett has extensive experience consulting in Asia, Europe and the US with companies of all sizes, including Fortune 500 firms. He is an investor and Board Member of GNumber, Inc. and also serves on the Advisory Boards of several companies. From 1994 to 1996, Doggett was a Cofounder and Chief Operating Officer of a Spanish language sports TV programming company. From 1996 to 1998, he was also an award winning talk show host on KVET-AM.
