MPA BRIDGE TUITION

The MPA Bridge program is an excellent investment. Admitted students are allowed to complete up to 12 credit hours of graduate courses in their senior year and pay undergraduate tuition for these courses. Students pay graduate tuition only after completing their bachelor's degree and transitioning to graduate standing.

In addition, certain students (particularly McCombs students and economics majors) have the potential to <u>waive up to 12 credit hours</u> of MPA core courses if the equivalent(s) are completed before transitioning to graduate standing. Course waivers reduce the total number of credit hours required for the MPA degree. Economics majors have the option to pursue a minor through the <u>Business Economics Option Program</u> and may qualify for course waivers.
