Avoid

- Bowties and vests
- Boots and sandals
- Short skirts or capri pants
- Heels over 3 inches tall
- Flashy make-up & jewelry
- Loud colors or "busy" designs

EXPO ATTIRE REQUIREMENTS

To enter the Career Expo all students are REQUIRED to wear:

- 1) A solid-colored, two-piece suit or suit jacket with coordinating pants or skirt that fits well
- 2) Dress shoes

Jeans, shorts, flip flops, running shoes/sneakers are not permitted.

Suggested Suit/Shoes Color Scheme

- Black Suit Black Shoes
- Navy Suit Black, Brown, or Navy Shoes
- Dark Gray Suit Black or Brown shoes

Recommendations For Making the Best First Impression

Suits:

- Solid-colored, two piece (jacket with pants or skirt) that fits well
- Suggested colors: black, navy, dark gray
- Make sure clothing is wrinkle-free & all tags are removed from your suit

Accessories:

- Polished shoes with matching socks
- Closed-toed shoes
- Low heels or dressy flats
- Belt color = shoe color

Grooming:

- Neat and simple
- Avoid strong perfumes or colognes
