

INTEGRATED MPA TUITION

The integrated MPA (iMPA) is great investment. Most iMPA students are able to pay for up to half of their graduate courses at the undergraduate tuition rate by completing graduate courses in their fourth year. Students are charged graduate tuition rates only in their fifth year (the last two long semesters). Academic advisors will assist students in minimizing tuition at the graduate rate.

Please note that students who were granted an out-of-state tuition waiver for the BBA degree will not be able to continue the waiver in the graduate year.

Federal financial aid for undergraduate students generally applies only to courses that fulfill bachelor's degree requirements. Graduate-level courses reserved for the MPA degree may not be eligible for undergraduate federal aid. Undergraduate students receiving federal financial aid should consult their MPA academic advisor to discuss enrollment strategies to reduce potential impact of this policy.
