

BBA Short Term International Programs Texas Competitive Scholarship Waiver

Purpose: The University of Texas at Austin is committed to supporting non-resident students and encouraging their participation in the BBA Short Term International Programs. In order to offset the cost of non-resident UT tuition, UT has committed (10) awards of \$1000 for need/merit based non-resident students. Students awarded the scholarship will also receive a UT waiver of nonresident tuition charges.

Scholarship Eligibility:

Applicants must be a non-resident undergraduate student, participating in one of the four BBA programs listed below. In addition, applicants must maintain good academic standing and must continue satisfactory progress toward their UT-Austin degree(s).

- Business Law Program in Edinburgh
- International Marketing Program in Paris
- BHP Management in Buenos Aires
- Supply Chain Management Program in Hong Kong

Application Process:

Applicant must submit the following items:

- 1. Completed application form (if handwritten, please print legibly).
 - a. (3) Short answer questions and (1) personal essay (typed only).
- 2. One (1) letter of recommendation from a faculty member or former employer. Letter may be:
 - a. Submitted to the BBA SIP office in a sealed envelope CBA 2.400
 - b. Submitted via email from recommender directly to Maria Terrazas at maria.terrazas@mccombs.utexas.edu
- 3. Submit application by March 1st at 5:00PM. No Exceptions made.

Award Instructions:

You must maintain good academic standing and must continue satisfactory progress toward your UT-Austin degree(s). Award recipients are required to fully engage and complete the full academic program, as prescribed. Further, you will be required to serve as a Global Ambassador during the 2013-2014 academic year. If for any reason you withdraw from the 2013 program, you will automatically forfeit the award.
